- Population within a 50 mile radius – 122,000 (Pulaski, Laclede & Phelps Co)
- Fort Leonard Wood – (Source: Strategic Planning Conference May 25, 2010)
  - Permanent military personnel – 7,100
  - Service members in training - 13,400
  - Permanent military personnel dependants – 16,700
  - DA Civilians – 3,600
  - Other Civilians – 5,400 (NAF, AAFES, Contractors, MWR)
  - Retirees – 22,600
  - Retirees family members – 33,900
  - An average of five people per graduate attends each military graduation ceremony that is held three times per week.
  - Over 100,000 service members graduated from basic training and technical schools in 2009.

## ST. ROBERT ECONOMIC GROWTH HIGHLIGHTS (2009):

- St. Robert generates **62%** of the total taxable reportable sales in Pulaski County.
- St. Robert has **22%** of the total commercial businesses in Pulaski County.
- Total reportable taxable sales from January 1999 through November 2009 – **\$1.70 billion**
- General sales tax revenues averaged **9%** over the last ten years.
- Total number of new residential dwelling units constructed over the last ten years – **783**
- Total construction valuation from 1999-2009 was **\$151.9 million** -
  - A total of **\$68.4 million** in new residential construction occurred over the last ten years.
  - A total of **\$67.9 million** in new commercial construction occurred over the last ten years.
  - A total of **\$15.6 million** in other construction valuation occurred over the last ten years.

## FORT LEONARD WOOD ECONOMIC IMPACTS:

- MILCON Funding – (Source: Strategic Planning Conference May 25, 2010)
  - FY08 - \$123 million
  - FY09 - \$93 million
  - FY10 - \$171 million
- Annual impact to local economy's - \$2.1 billion
- Average officer rank is Major, with an average salary of \$75K-\$80K.
- Average enlisted rank is a senior Staff Sergeant, with a salary of \$35K-\$39K. This does not include basic housing allowance and ration benefits which vary by rank and marital status.
- The average government service Civilian salary is \$45K.
