PARK AND RECREATION IMPROVEMENTS

On July 1, 2009 at 11:00 a.m. the City will host a Ribbon Cutting for the newly constructed Bosa Park located at 109 Lee Drive which includes a playground, picnic pavilion and barbeque grills and by the end of the year will include a walking trail. The completion of Bosa Park is latest addition to the city parks and recreation system.

On August 4th, the city will be asking voters to approve a 1/4 of one percent sales tax on all retail sales in the city to support improvements

to the St. Robert Park and Recreation System. The proposed improvements were presented at the recent Town Hall meetings include an aquatic facility that includes a community center facility with an indoor pool, interactive splash area, concessions, and birthday party area. Also proposed is a youth center, gymnasium, driving range/pitch & putt, RV Park, and other facilities and programs to provide family recreation and entertainment to our community. The City conducted a

community assessment survey and has hosted four Town Hall meetings in order to get input and ideas from the community as to what recreational facilities and programs are needed and wanted to enhance the quality of life in our community.
