Council Approves Final Site for Aquatic Facility

The City Council approved the final site location of the new Aquatic Facility for the City of St. Robert. Based on the evaluation of site engineering evaluations, the St. Robert Park Committee recommended to the

City Council that the new facility be located on the undeveloped tract adjacent to the playground in the Municipal Park. Final design drawings and specifications will be presented to the Park Committee within the next

three weeks for the publication of bid solicitations. There is a lot of energy and excitement in anticipation for the start of construction and the opening next year of this great facility.

Bosa Park Phase II Improvements

The Marines from the Marine Corps Detachment, Engineer Equipment Instruction Company began constructing the initial improvements to Phase II of the Bosa Heights Park on September 25, 2009.

The Marines constructed a 24 foot all-weather pedestrian

bridge and installed 960 feet of walking trail timber border.

Fall Clean Up Day Scheduled

Fall Clean Up day is scheduled for Wednesday, October 14, 2009 for St. Robert residents inside the city limits who pay for trash services. Place items that need picked up by the curb by 7:00 am.

The following items **WILL** be picked up: Appliances (i.e.) washing machines, dryers, heaters, construction waste: (i.e.) sheetrock, lumber (minimal amounts that will

fit into a trash can), empty paint cans, furniture, VCRs.

The following items will **NOT** be picked up: T.V.'s, computers, microwaves, tires, yard debris: (i.e.) leaves, branches, soil, vehicle or lawn mower batteries.

If you have large appliances that need picked up, you must call and let Zeigenbein Sanitation know this as it has to be

picked up in a separate vehicle.

If you have any questions, you may call Zeigenbein Sanitation at 336-4848.

Electronics and household hazardous material (i.e. household paint, chemicals, etc.) may be dropped off at the Transfer Station by appointment only. Call the Transfer Station at (573) 336-5155 with any questions.

Peggy Ave. and Jeffrey Ave. Street Improvements

The street improvements of Peggy Avenue and Jeffrey Avenue in the Paddock Estates Subdivision has begun with the staking of the street right-of-ways.

Actual work is projected to commence in mid October with the installation of a storm

water inlet box, milling and removal of the existing asphalt surface, and the construction of 1,145 feet of a new 2-inch asphalt overlay.

The Public Works Department will ensure that the public stays informed of the pending street improvements and the

dates the work will commence.

Could your deck or balcony be dangerous?

Consider repairing or rebuilding your deck if you see any of these warnings:

Missing Connections: A deck should be built using a series of wood members, nails, screws, and metal connectors to create a continuous load path. Look at how your deck is built; if all you see are nails, your deck could be unsafe.

Loose Connections: Issues such as wobbly

railings, loose stairs, and ledgers that appear to be pulling away from the home are all causes for concern.

Corrosion of Connectors and Fasteners: Metal connectors, nails, and screws can corrode over time and weaken the structure of your deck.

Rot: Wood members within the deck frame that have rotted may no longer be able to perform the function for which they

were installed, making your deck unstable.

Cracks: As wood ages, it is common for cracks to develop. Large cracks or excessive cracking overall can weaken your deck.
